Regulations “6 Days”

We do everything possible to provide ideal conditions for participants and companions throughout the event.

Article 1: THE RACE

Free-pace individual race for runners and walkers.

START: Sunday 6 June 2027 at 12:00 (noon) and finish on Saturday 12 June 2027 at 12:00 (noon).

LOCATION: Vallon Pont d'Arc (07) France, at Camping Nature Parc l'Ardéchois.

Article 2: REGISTRATION

Registration is done by mail using the official entry form, or online.

No registration will be accepted on site.

CATEGORIES: Reserved exclusively for senior and masters categories (Men and Women)

«In application of the law of 2 March 2022 aimed at democratizing sport in France, and its implementing decree of 22 June 2022, the French Athletics Federation (FFA), on the advice of its Medical Commission, decided to replace the requirement to provide a medical certificate of no contraindication with an educational and information program on the health risks of practicing athletics, called the “Health Prevention Pathway” (or “PPS”). Already applicable to all adult FFA license holders since September 2023, this requirement now applies to all adult participants wishing to register for a race, who must therefore complete the Health Prevention Pathway within the three months before the event concerned. This PPS will be available on the FFA's online platform.»

Registration deadline: 31 March 2027

A registration validated by the organization will be considered complete if it includes all of the following documents:

- The official entry form, duly completed and signed
- The Health Prevention Pathway certificate, or a copy of your current sports license

Registration takes effect on the date all elements of the file are received; reserved bungalow places will only be taken into account with a COMPLETE file.

Registrations must be sent back **before 31 March 2027**, the registration deadline, by email to ultrarunning.organisationmail.com or by post to **ULTRA RUNNING ORGANISATION – 117 Route du Pont Louis XIII – 07000 PRIVAS – FRANCE.**

Article 3: WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRY

Every entry is personal and, to avoid any dispute, requests to withdraw an entry must be submitted before 15 March 2027.

IMPORTANT: After this deadline, no further request will be considered, including a request to defer registration to the following year.

For a registered withdrawal:

- Before 31 December 2026: 10% of the registration fee will be withheld
- From 1st January to 15 March 2027: 50% of the registration fee will be withheld; beyond this date, no request will be accepted.
- Refunds will be processed as soon as possible, within a maximum of 3 months after the event.

Article 4: INSURANCE

The organizers' civil liability is covered by an insurance policy in accordance with the Charter for Off-Stadium Races. FFA license holders benefit from the guarantees provided by the personal accident insurance linked to their license. It is the responsibility of other participants to arrange their own insurance. The organizers decline all liability in the event of an accident or health issue resulting from a poor state of health. Theft will not be covered by the Organization. We advise you to take out cancellation insurance with a specialized provider.

Article 5: BIB NUMBERS

Bib numbers may be collected at the event venue on Saturday 5 June 2027 from 4:00pm to 7:00pm, and on Sunday 6 June 2027 from 8:00am to 9:00am.

Wearing the bib number is mandatory, on the front, unfolded and visible throughout the event. They will only be issued if the registration file is complete.

The event's official t-shirt must always be worn at the start, during the first full lap.

The event briefing will take place on Sunday 6 June 2027 at 10:00am. All participants must be present; the verbal instructions given must be followed throughout the race.

Article 6: TIMING

Timing will be carried out by an accredited timekeeper, JMG Chrono, using an electronic timing system (electronic chip worn on the ankle).

Every registered participant will receive 1 electronic chip, which will be automatically activated at the start line and used to check racing consistency at various points along the course. A competitor who does not cover the entire course will not be able to be ranked at the finish.

The electronic chip must be returned to the organization at the finish of the race by each competitor. In the event of withdrawal, the chip must be returned to the organization on the day of withdrawal or departure.

WARNING: Any chip not returned by the end of the 6 days will be charged €50 and will result in immediate disqualification from the event.

The company offers participants lap-by-lap tracking as well as a personalized messaging system to their mobile phone.

No personal messages printed on paper.

Article 7: RANKINGS

An overall ranking (M and F) will be determined chronologically by the number of kilometers covered by each competitor during the event.

An overall ranking (M and F) for the «walking» category will be established if there are at least 5 participants. Below 5 participants, they will be included in the overall ranking without distinction of discipline.

Ranking by age category.

Article 8: AWARDS

A cup (or trophy) for the top 3 finishers in each individual ranking (Men and Women) for runners and walkers, and a medal for every participant.

An award given to each winner by age category (Men and Women).

Article 9: ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation options:

1. Bungalow shared by 2 people (2 runners, or 1 runner + 1 companion).
2. Bungalow shared by 3, 4 or 5 people. **ONLY ONE** companion allowed per participant in a bungalow.

Bungalow places are assigned to participants by the organizers upon receipt of the complete file, including payment. The organizers try to accommodate personal requests and preferences, but participants must accept the final accommodation plan. There will be no changes to the accommodation plan. Only officially registered participants and companions are permitted to stay in the bungalows. No guests are allowed in the bungalows, including unregistered family members.

A deposit of €100 must be given to the organization when collecting bib numbers, for participants staying in a bungalow. It will be returned after the accommodation is vacated, provided it is returned in the same condition as at check-in.

Participants wishing to book a bungalow must respect the key hand-over times on Sunday 13 June 2027 between 9:00am and 12:00pm (noon) in order to recover their deposit. Those who do not respect these times will lose their deposit.

Participants and companions must vacate the bungalows and campsite spots (motorhomes and individual tents) before 12:00pm (noon) on Sunday 13 June 2027.

3. Motorhome and personal tent

A site layout plan for motorhomes and personal tents at the campsite will be drawn up by the organization. A member of the organization will be present on arrival day to guide and place you. There will be no changes to the layout plan.

4. Tents offered by the organization

Article 10: FOOD

A welcome drink and a pasta-party-style meal are offered the evening before the start – included in the registration fee.

On **12 June 2027**:

- There will be no lunch, but a snack will be served from 11:00am.

There will be no specific menu for special diets (vegetarian, gluten-free, vegan, etc.). Thank you for your understanding, and please arrange any necessary adaptations yourself if needed.

After the awards ceremony, a buffet-style dinner will be offered to participants and companions.

For companions staying in a bungalow, all meals are included.

Article 11: AID STATIONS

1. ORGANIZATION aid station

A 24-hour aid station will be available throughout the event, offering hot, cold, sweet and savory food. Nutritional needs will be covered for this type of event. Energy drinks will also be provided.

2. PERSONAL aid station

A specific area for personal supplies, with tables and chairs, will be set up within the aid station zone. It is up to each competitor to plan and bring their own personal food as a supplement, according to their preferences.

3. Sustainable development

In order to honor our commitment to sustainable development, no plastic cups will be used at the aid station table. You will be given 2 cups as part of your bib number collection kit. **Competitors must bring their own personal cutlery.**

Containers will be made available during the night service and must be returned to the organization.

Article 12: RACE PROCEEDINGS

Companions on foot or by bicycle are strictly prohibited on the course throughout the entire event.

Walking poles are prohibited on the course.

Competitors registered in the «Walking» category must strictly comply with FFA regulations for this discipline. Walking judges will be present on the course to enforce this regulation.

Article 13: FACILITIES

Showers and toilets (campsite facilities)

Companions' vehicles will not have access to the campsite; they must park in the outside car park. ALL vehicles belonging to participants and companions must be parked

Article 14: MEDICAL

Participants and companions must inform the organizers of any known illness, disability, or food allergies. A medical team (nurse, physiotherapist and osteopath) will be present on site throughout the event for participants and their companions.

Article 15: AWARDS CEREMONY

The awards ceremony will take place **on Saturday 12 June 2027 at 6:00pm.**

Registered participants and companions are invited to a buffet dinner at the end of the ceremony.

Article 16: DISPUTES

In the event of a dispute, only the Race Director will resolve any issues.

Article 17: BEHAVIOR AND ATTIRE

We require irreproachable behavior from competitors and companions throughout the event. We will be vigilant on this point given the welcome we receive at this campsite. Participants and companions are expressly asked to show the greatest respect for the sanitary facilities made available by the campsite. The organization reserves the right to impose sanctions in the event of inappropriate behavior. Use of mobile phones for calls and text messages is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED ON THE TRACK**, however it is permitted for listening to music.

Article 18: EVENT CANCELLATION

If the event has to be cancelled due to force majeure or for a reason beyond the organization's control, no refund of registration fees will be made and no compensation will be paid.

Article 19: USE OF IMAGE

By entering the event, each competitor expressly authorizes the association Ultra Running Organisation (or its successors in interest) to use, have used, reproduce or have reproduced their name, image, voice and sporting performance in connection with the event, for any direct or derivative exploitation of the event, on any medium, worldwide, by any means known or unknown to date, and for the entire duration of protection currently granted to such direct or derivative exploitation by legislative or regulatory provisions, judicial and/or arbitral decisions of any country, as well as by current or future international conventions, including any extensions that may be made to this duration.

CNIL: In accordance with the French law known as "Informatique et Libertés" ("Data Protection Act") of 6 January 1978, you have a right of access to and rectification of your personal data. Through us, you may receive offers from other companies or associations. If you do not wish to receive these, simply write to us stating your last name, first name and address.

Article 20: ACCEPTANCE

Every competitor registered and participating in the «6 jours de France» declares that they have read these regulations and accept all of their clauses without restriction.
